

NEBOSH NATIONAL GENERAL CERTIFICATE (REF:APIXNGC001)

Who Should Attend?

Individuals that as part of their role have health and safety responsibilities and require a nationally recognised qualification in health and safety.

Course Objectives

To provide a formal vocational qualification in health and safety, examined to NVQ level 3.

Course Description

A 10 day course covering all aspects of health and safety, with the first week concentrating on health and safety management systems and the second week on the control of workplace hazards.

Pre-requisites

Previous basic health and safety experience and / or qualifications e.g. IOSH Managing Safely would be an advantage, but not essential.

Course Outcome

There will be 2 (2 hour) exam papers taken on the same day, NGC1 and GC2, with short bullet style and essay type questions. In addition to this, there is a work based practical report (GC3) (approx 1000 words) to complete.
